FOREWORD

Basic Education is statutorily the responsibility of the States and the Local Governments. The intervention of the Federal Government in the sub-sector is to assist States and the Local Government Areas for "the purpose of uniform and qualitative basic education throughout Nigeria". A major step in the renewed commitment of the Federal Government and the UBE Commission to improve basic education delivery processes across the country is the development of the Medium Term Basic Education Strategic Plan (MTBESP) at state level and the aggregation of the States' plans into a the National Medium Term Basic Education Strategic Plan (NMTBESP).

The enactment of the Universal Basic Education Act, 2004 gave legal and institutional reinforcements to the UBE programme. The Act establishes the Universal Basic Education Commission (UBEC) at the Federal level for national coordination and monitoring of programme implementation. It also stipulates legislative obligations for the establishment of the State Universal Basic Education Board (SUBEB) by each of the 36 States and the FCT for programme implementation. Specifically, Section 9 of the Act stipulates that one of the major functions of UBEC is to:

“collate and prepare after consultation with the States and Local Governments, periodic Master Plans for a balanced and coordinated development of Basic Education in Nigeria, including areas of possible intervention in the provision of adequate basic education facilities.”

The Act also makes provisions for the establishment of the UBE Intervention Fund (UBE-IF) of not less than 2% of the Consolidated Revenue Fund (CRF) of the Federal Government that guarantees sustainable funding for implementing the UBE programme. The implementation of the programme has remained on course since inception, although with less than satisfactory results. Nonetheless, the UBE-IF, along with other funding sources, have boosted public and private sector investments in basic education by all tiers of government, non-state shareholders and international development partners. The need to translate this boost into yielding the expected results is the focus of the emphasis on development of Plans for the sub-sector that would guide interventions, lead to efficient utilization of resources and enable systematic tracking. However, increased funding has not appeared to have yielded the expected outcomes

It is instructive that poor planning, and oftentimes lack of planning, has been identified as a major contributory factor to Nigeria's underperformance in basic education provision. Lack of quality planning has resulted in a regime of inefficient and ineffective coordination, poor resource mobilization and utilization, and limited progress in education service delivery.

Education is a shared responsibility of the three tiers of government in Nigeria – Federal, State and Local – with several non-state actors and development partners playing various complementary roles as major stakeholders. This has become more of a challenge to institutional and system strengthening rather than an opportunity to enhance service delivery. This challenge arises from lack of coordination, role conflicts and unnecessary duplication of efforts among the varied stakeholders that undermine effective management. Huge investments in basic education have failed to yield the expected results and thus have not translated into improvements in key performance indicators due to the absence of a strategic direction and an enabling framework to synergize government and other stakeholders' interventions and actions. The situation can only be best addressed with a purposeful and robust strategic planning intervention and the use of quality strategic plans to drive basic education service delivery.

The need to have in place a Plan Document particularly at the national level was informed by the critical roles the Commission plays in the orderly development of Basic Education. The Plan Document will also serve as negotiation, collaboration and accountability tool for engagement with national stakeholders and Development Partners.

Recognizing that some states, especially those that have the support of Development Partners, have developed State Education Sector Operational Plans/Medium Term Sector Strategy (SESOPs/MTSS), UBEC rode on the impetus provided by the Ministerial Strategic Plan (MSP) to advocate for the development of the Medium Term Basic Education Strategic Plan (MTBESP) by the 36 States and the FCT. This has culminated in a National Medium Term Basic Education Strategic Plan (NMTBESP). UBEC communicated at different Meetings that the Plan Development Process would be a distillation of the Basic Education components of the MSP and would include other elements that are exclusively the responsibilities of State Universal Basic Education Boards (SUBEBs), Universal Basic Education Commission (UBEC), National Commission for Nomadic Education (NCNE) and National Commission for Mass Literacy, Adult and Non-Formal Education (NMEC).

The National Medium Term Basic Education Strategic Plan (NMTBESP) is a 3-year Medium Term Operational Plan that details the implementation of the Basic Education components in the ***“Education for Change Ministerial Strategic Plan (MSP) for 2016-2019”*** which contains an aggregation of the 36 States' and Federal Capital Territory's (FCT) Medium Term Basic Education Strategic Plan (MTBESP) in addition to Strategic Basic Education activities that are direct responsibilities of the UBEC, NCNE and NMEC. It also focuses on targets, strategies and actions that have been reviewed and refined which reflect current realities. They are therefore informed by:

- Resource availability and funding realities;
- The Sustainable Development Goals – (Agenda 2030 on Education: the post 2015 Millennium Development Goals);

- The vision to transform lives through education, recognizing the important role of education as a main driver of development.

The 2017-2019 NMTBESP priorities are centred on the following:

- i. Out of School;
- ii. Basic Education;
- iii. Teacher Professional Development;
- iv. Basic Education Curriculum;
- v. Education data and planning;
- vi. Information and Communication Technology (ICT) in education;
- vii. Library Services; and
- viii. Funding.

It is important to note that **Funding** was added because it is an activity that the Commission engages in as part of its mandate.

The development of the MTBESP was coordinated by UBEC and supported by UNICEF, the World Bank and DFID. This final Plan is the result of a series of participatory and technical processes involving all 36 states and the FCT. Guidelines were developed and shared with States in a series of advocacy, training and actual planning meetings that helped them shape their own State Plans. The close interaction with States contributed to increased ownership and commitment to utilisation by States and enhanced their capacity to develop and review their plans going forward as well as in strengthening States' teams in the field of Educational Planning and Management. States have actively participated in the process of developing the Plan and, therefore, are able to own the process.

On the whole, the NMTBESP provides strategic directions for achieving lifelong learning. Fragmentation and silo operations were other issues that UBEC addressed through this planning process. Thus, a pre-condition for the acceptance of Plans submitted by SUBEBs was that they work with State Ministries of Education (SMoEs) in developing the Plans. This way, SMoEs had adequate knowledge of and made inputs into the Plans, which are implemented by UBEC and SUBEBs.

GLOSSARY OF TERMS

Access - This is the ability of all school age children to have equal opportunity in education.

Better Education Service Delivery for All (BESDA) – It is a World Bank-assisted programme being implemented by the Government of Nigeria in three result areas of: (i) increasing equitable access for out-of-school children, (ii) improving literacy and (iii) strengthening accountability for results

International Development Partners (IDPs) – These are development aid agencies that provide regional and international development aid or assistance.

Medium Term Basic Education Strategic Plan (MTBESP) – This is intended to link policy, planning and budgets in the Basic Education sub-sector. It will set out the projects and programmes that will be executed in the sub-sector over a three-year period, costing, and sources of the funding and the implementers of the programmes.

Ministerial Strategic Plan (MSP) – This is a road map, which focuses on ten pillars that guide the Federal Ministry of Education to address the myriads of challenges confronting Nigeria's education sector.

Monitoring and Evaluation Framework - An M&E framework is a table that describes the indicators that are used to measure the success of a programme in accordance with agreed timelines.

Planning - Planning is a fundamental management function, which involves deciding beforehand, what is to be done, when is it to be done, how it is to be done and who is going to do it. It is an intellectual process which lays down the objectives of an organization and develops various courses of action, by which the organization can achieve those objectives. It chalks out exactly, how to attain a specific goal.

Quality – Quality involves making organizations perform for their stakeholders – from improving products, services, systems and processes, to making sure that the whole organization is fit and effective.

Quality Assurance - Quality Assurance is a programme for the systematic monitoring and evaluation of the various aspects of a project, service, or facility to ensure that standards of quality are being met.

Risk Factors - These are issues identified in the educational sector which could lead to a reduction in performance or results or poor learning outcome.

School – This is an ECCDE, Primary or Junior Secondary school but does not include a class for religious instruction, a trade Centre, a training college or any other institution intended solely for the education of adults.

Strategy Formulation- This is an analytical process of selection of the best suitable course of action to meet the organizational objectives and vision. It is one of the steps of the strategic management process.

Strategy Implementation–This is a process that puts plans and strategies into action to reach desired goals.

Situation Analysis – A systematic collection and evaluation of past and present economic, political, social, and technological data, aimed at (1) identification of internal and external forces that may influence the performance and choice of strategies, and (2) assessment of the current and future strengths, weaknesses, opportunities, and threats in an organization.

System Strengthening – This is a systemic policy reforms approach aimed at improving learning outcomes and equity with the participation of all relevant stakeholders. It takes place at all levels from Education Ministries, Departments and Agencies to Local Governments and schools. Therefore, Nigerian ownership and partnership are central operating principles and key to the success of all education programmes. Embedded in the system strengthening approach is full Federal, State and Local ownership.

UBE Act, 2004 - This Act is also called the Compulsory, Free Universal Basic Education Act, 2004. It provides for compulsory, free universal basic education for all children of primary and junior secondary school age in the Federal Republic of Nigeria. It further seeks to provide punishment for parents for failing to comply with its provisions.

Universal Basic Education Programme - It covers early childhood care education and the nine (9) years of formal schooling (uninterrupted free and compulsory basic education for children from primary through junior secondary school age of 5 to 14 years), adult literacy and non-formal education, skills acquisition programmes and the education of special groups such as nomads and migrants, the girl-child, and women, almajirai, street children and disabled groups. (**UBE Act, 2004**). It was introduced by the Federal Government of Nigeria as its response to the achievement of Education for All (EFA) Goals in 1999.

SECTION ONE

Section One contains the evolution and development process of the Medium Term Basic Education Strategic Plan (MTBESP) at state and national levels. It details the National Agencies involved in the Implementation of the UBE Programme; Implementation mechanisms and guidelines, as well as the situations analysis of Basic Education in Nigeria.

1.0 Introduction

The success of any system of education is hinged on proper **Planning** that recognizes and addresses key requirements issues of quality education such as access and equity as well as system strengthening. Such a Plan that would take into account all dimensions of access in a sound education system including physical access, quality access, economic access and equity; standards and quality which involves infrastructure, teacher quality, motivation and retention, curriculum relevance and review as well as learner support services which will ensure that service delivery in the Basic Education Sub-sector is guided.

The Universal Basic Education (UBE) Programme is a-Nine-Year Basic Education programme. It was launched in 1999 and designed to be implemented by the government and people of the Federal Republic of Nigeria to eradicate illiteracy, ignorance and poverty as well as stimulate and accelerate national development, political consciousness and national integration. Its subsequent backing by Federal legislation and concurrent State legislative enactment was a defining bold initiative and intervention for Nigeria to fulfil its commitment to, and achieve universal, free, compulsory and inclusive quality Basic Education provision for all. UBE is ultimately aimed at laying a solid foundation for lifelong learning by providing suitable learning, self-awareness, citizenship and life skills to learners.

1.1 Implementation of UBE Programme

While Basic Education is the education offered to children aged between 3 and 14 years and comprises: 3 years of Early Childhood Care Development and Education, 6 years of Primary Education and 3 years of Junior Secondary Education (**FME, 2009**), the Universal Basic Education entails Early Childhood Care Education (ECCE), the nine (9) years of formal schooling (primary – junior secondary), adult literacy and non-formal education, skills acquisition programmes and the education of special groups such as nomads and migrants, girl-child, women, *almajirai*, street children and disabled groups (**UBE Act, 2004**).

The UBE Act makes 9-year basic education universal, free and compulsory in public primary and junior secondary schools. In the spirit of cooperative federalism, all the three tiers of government (Federal, State and Local) are involved in the implementation of the Universal Basic Education Programme (UBEP). The Act also recognizes and preserves the exclusive constitutional responsibility of States and Local Governments in Nigeria to provide basic education. The Federal Government's role is an intervention to ensure uniform, equitable and qualitative provision of basic education throughout the country.

1.2 The National Agencies for the UBE Programme

The National Agencies involved in the Implementation of the UBE Programme are the Federal Ministry of Education (FME), UBEC, National Commission for Nomadic Education (NCNE), National Commission for Mass Literacy, Adult and Non-Formal Education (NMEC), States (SMoEs, SUBEBs, LGEAs), Schools, Non-Governmental Organizations (NGOs)/Community-Based Organizations (CBOs) and Faith-Based Organizations (FBOs), Private Providers and Operators of Basic Education Institutions.

1.2.1 Federal Ministry of Education (FME)

The Ministry is responsible for policy in all matters connected with education in Nigeria.

Vision

To become an economic model, delivering sound education for public good.

Mission

To use education for fostering development of all Nigerian Citizens to their full potentials in the promotion of a strong, democratic, egalitarian, prosperous, indivisible and indissoluble sovereign nation under God.

Mandate

The mandate of the Ministry is to:

- ▶ Formulate and co-ordinate a National Policy on Education;
- ▶ Collect and collate data for purposes of educational planning and financing;
- ▶ Prescribe and maintain uniform standard of education throughout the country;
- ▶ Control and monitor the quality of education in the country;
- ▶ Harmonize educational policies and procedures of all the States of the Federation through the instrumentality of the National Council on Education (NCE);
- ▶ Effect co-operation in educational matters on an international scale; and
- ▶ Develop curricula and syllabuses at the national level.

1.2.2 Universal Basic Education Commission (UBEC)

UBEC is a federal government agency established to serve as a prime energizer of all national movements for the actualization of the nation's Universal Basic Education (UBE) vision working in concert with all stakeholders, thus mobilizing the nation's creative energies to ensure that ***Education for All is the Responsibility of All.***

The functions of UBEC as captured in the UBE Act, 2004 include to:

- Formulate the policy guidelines for the successful operation of the universal basic education programme in the Federation;
- Collate and prepare after consultation with the States and Local Governments, and other relevant stakeholders, periodic master plans for a balanced and coordinated development of basic education in Nigeria including areas of possible intervention in the provision of adequate basic education facilities;
- Carry out in concert with the States and Local Governments at regular intervals, a personnel audit of teaching and non-teaching staff of all basic education institutions in Nigeria;
- Receive block grant from the Federal Government and allocate to the States and Local Governments and other relevant agencies implementing the Universal Basic Education in accordance with an approved formula as may be laid down by the Board of the Commission and approved by the Federal Executive Council;
- Monitor Federal inputs into the implementation of basic education;
- Prescribe the minimum standards for Basic Education throughout Nigeria in line with the National Policy on Education and directives from National Council on Education (NCE);
- mobilize all other stakeholders' support for the effective and efficient implementation of the programme;
- present periodic progress report on the implementation of UBE to the Management and Board of UBEC; and
- establish a Basic Education Data Bank.

Vision

To be a world class education intervention and regulatory agency for the promotion of uniform, qualitative and functional basic education.

Mission

The Commission shall operate as an intervention, coordinating and monitoring Agency to progressively improve the capacity of States, Local Government Agencies and Communities in the provision of unfettered access to high quality basic education in Nigeria.

Core Values

The core values of the Commission are as follows:

- Honesty and Accountability
- Integrity and Transparency
- Teamwork with Commitment.

1.2.3 National Commission for Nomadic Education (NCNE)

This Commission was established through the instrumentality of NCNE CAP 243 LFN 2004 (formerly NCNE Decree No. 41 of 1989).

The role of the Commission is to provide:

- Basic Education, Early Childhood Care Development and Education, Lower Basic and Middle Basic Education;
- Extension Services and Animal Husbandry Services;
- Relevant functional literacy and numeracy skills for adults;
- Life improvement skills for Better livelihood

Vision

Integrating the nomads into the national life by providing them with relevant and functional basic education and improving their livelihood skills, levels of income and productivity as well as equipping them to compete favourably in the nation's socio-economic and political affairs

Mission

To serve as a prime mover and working in concert with all the Universal Basic Education (UBE) stakeholders for the actualization of qualitative education for the nomadic populations in the country.

Core Values

The core values of the Commission are Excellence in striving to provide a solid foundation for basic functional Education and exemplary character for the nomadic child.

1.2.4 National Commission for Mass Literacy, Adult and Non-Formal Education (NMEC)

The National Commission for Mass Literacy, Adult and Non-Formal Education, (NMEC) is a statutory Federal Government parastatal under the Federal Ministry of Education, established by Decree No. 17 of June 26, 1990 now (Act No 18 of 2004) and took off on July 5, 1991. The Commission has its Corporate Headquarter in Abuja and is headed by an Executive Secretary. The Commission has a zonal office in each of the six geopolitical

zones of the country: North-East – Bauchi; North West – Katsina; North Central – Minna; South West – Ibadan; South- South – Benin; South East – Owerri.

Mandate

The functions and responsibilities of the Commission include to:

- Formulate and issue policy guidelines on all matters relating to adult and non-formal education activities in Nigeria;
- Co-ordinate and monitor the successful implementation of all adult and non-formal education programmes in Nigeria;
- Receive funds from the Federal Government and allocate same to states and such other agencies that implement adult and non-formal education programmes in Nigeria;
- Solicit, receive and disburse grants, endowments and gifts to agencies that implement adult and non-formal education in Nigeria;
- Undertake quality assurance activities in the implementation of adult and non-formal education programmes in Nigeria;
- Motivate and mobilize people to participate in mass literacy, adult and non-formal education programmes through advocacy visits and the use of the mass media, especially the radio, television and mobile cinema;
- Conduct research on adult and non-formal education programmes in Nigeria,
- Develop and disseminate curricula and instructional materials for adult and non-formal education in Nigeria; and
- Establish pilot mass literacy, adult and non-formal education centres and classes across Nigeria.

Vision

The Vision of the Commission is to eradicate illiteracy and provide Non-Formal and Continuing Education within the context of Lifelong Learning for Sustainable Development.

Mission

The Mission of the Commission is to develop and sustain mass education for an enduring learning society as a critical lever for self-reliance and national development.

1.2.5 States: SMOEs/SUBEBS/LGEAs

The State Ministry of Education makes policies that govern Basic Education delivery, supervises the SUBEBs and ensures compliance with all the agreements reached at the National Council on Education (NCE). SUBEBs and LGEAs are responsible of the proper implementation of UBE programme in states and LGAs. Their roles include:

- accessing and utilization of FGN-UBE intervention fund for the implementation of the Programme;

- making adequate budgetary provisions for ensuring implementing quality in schools ;
- collating, storing and retrieving of basic education data in SUBEBs, LGEAs and schools;
- ensuring equity in distribution of UBE resources as contained in their respective States' UBE Laws and LGEA Bye-Laws;
- ensuring orderly and systematic implementation of the programme following set minimum standards to give access;
- maintaining equity and ensure quality basic education service delivery to all school-age children in formal settings and adults in non-formal settings;
- ensuring that the services rendered to the clientele in public schools are free and qualitative. Such services include provision of textbooks, classrooms, furniture and mid-day meals, where applicable; and
- collaborating/partnering with other stakeholders to render other necessary services such as provision of uniforms, transportation, etc., that are not free to the clientele under the UBE Act, 2004 provisions.

1.2.6 Schools

The school is the environment that produces the contents and processes which learners encounter and that lead to diverse results, some intended and others unintended. The school operates at 3 levels of Basic Education as follows:

- i. Early Childhood/Pre-primary Education
- ii. Primary Education
- iii. Junior Secondary Education

1.2.7 Non-Governmental Organizations (NGOs)/Community-Based Organizations(CBOs) and Faith-Based Organizations (FBOs), Private Providers and Operators of Basic Education Institutions

These are organizations that partner with UBEC, SUBEBs and LGEAs, at all levels of Basic Education, in the implementation of UBE Programme particularly in monitoring and evaluation of projects and mobilizing resources. They also participate in the application of Basic Education mechanisms, as the need arises, either directly or in collaboration with other agencies that play similar roles.

1.3 The Development of the NMTBESP

The NMTBESP was developed to fill the apparent vacuum in the use of evidence in planning the education sector. Prior to the initiation of this plan development process in January 2016, there had been a persistent lack of coherence between States' actual needs and requests submitted to UBEC for funding and the real needs of the States as evident in a situation analysis. This mismatch led to inability to match resources expended with real achievements in the basic education sector. The fact that up to then,

there had been very low recognition of planning as a necessary tool in education service delivery made. This changed with the introduction of the MSP.

The launch of the MSP by the Federal Ministry of Education had further provided an impetus for a culture of sustained use of evidence in Planning across the 36 states and the FCT by laying down the much-needed strategic directions for States to align with. In order to promote a Bottom-Up approach and ensure ownership and leadership of the States in the planning process, States were, first supported to develop their Medium Term Basic Education Strategic Plans (MTBESPs) and subsequently, the Plans were aggregated to the NMTBESP. The NMTBESP also addresses the priority pillars of the MSP while capturing the states' realities and other UBEC areas of intervention.

1.3.1 The Medium Term Basic Education Strategic Plan (MTBESP)

The Medium Term Basic Education Strategic Plan is a three year framework of public expenditure within which available internal and external resources are allocated among various economic sectors. It is:

- a procedure of matching limited resources with unlimited needs of the citizens;
- making the plan an integral system, through which all available resources (government, donors and lenders) are allocated on the basis of defined policy priorities;
- developing sectoral strategies that set out future priority spending.

More precisely, the plan describes how particular units or groups of units of government will deliver evidence-based outputs:

- within the limitation of available resources;
- that will contribute to evidence-based outcomes; and
- are in line with the overall policy priorities.

In developing the plans, states paid attention to the availability of funds over a given period of time through a trends analysis. This enabled the States to project what they are likely to receive from different sources and how they can apply these in redressing the recurring challenges in basic education. States also identified the availability or otherwise of resources human and material that they would to execute their plans for the three-year period. This means at the very least that there must be reasonable expectations of availability of:

- Adequate money, and
- Capacity.

To this end therefore, UBEC in collaboration with the SUBEBs and with support from the UNICEF and the World Bank has developed the States' and National Medium Term Basic

Education Plans (SMTBESPs/NMTBESP). The specific Action Plan for a Quarter or a particular year is therefore a sub-set of the SMTBESP. All States' MTBESPs are brought together in the NMTBESP, thus providing UBEC with a one-stop-plan that contains all the States' priorities for ease of aligning resources, tracking and reporting. The NMTBESP has become the much-needed document that can enhance accountability and greater transparency in the disbursement and tracking of resource deployment in basic education.

1.3.2 Rationale/Purpose of the MTBESPs

The recognition of the critical importance of Strategic Planning in programming for results and its efficiency in linking policies to plans has become compelling. In promoting and supporting the development of Sector Plans, UBEC plans to link annual requests from States with real Education Sector needs at State level to ensure that requests submitted for funding are derived from evidence-based Strategic Plans that have been developed in the respective States. It is envisaged that the State Strategic Plans would facilitate a results-focused linkage of policy to planning, deployment of resources to ensure enhanced sector performance and value for money in implementation.

The main purpose of the NMTBESP and SMTBESPs is to institute and sustain effective coordination of the resources, interventions and activities of UBEC, SUBEBs, LGAs and all key stakeholders, including International Development Partners in the basic education sub-sector. The objectives are to ensure that:

- i. the financing framework forecasts for Basic Education in Nigeria are systematic, integrated, and transparently managed;
- ii. planning and utilization of resources in basic education provision are evidence-based and benchmarked against national development goals and objectives; and
- iii. management and utilization of all available resources for basic education are resourceful and result-oriented.

1.3.3 The Targets of the NMTBESP and SMTBESPs

The targets of the MTBESPs are to ensure that:

- i. all schools have adequate resources and capacity for inclusive access and quality teaching and learning in order to reduce number of out-of-school children;
- ii. all children of school-age are enrolled, attending and fully participating in safe and stimulating basic schools to increase enrolment rates in adult and non-formal, nomadic, ECCDE, primary and junior secondary education and ensure inclusiveness for all categories of learners irrespective of their health conditions and socio-economic status;
- iii. all teachers have access to improved teacher professional development (TPD);

- iv. all children in school are learning, meeting specified benchmarks and achieving set learning outcomes; and
- v. there is systematic increase in the quantity and quality of physical infrastructure, instructional materials, curriculum, early reading and numeracy programmes.

To this end, therefore, UBEC in collaboration with the SUBEBs and with support from UNICEF and the World Bank has developed the States' and National Medium Term Basic Education Strategic Plans (SMTBESPs/NMTBESP). The specific Action Plan for a Quarter or a particular year is therefore a sub-set of the SMTBESP.

1.3.4 Methodology for Development of the MTBESP

In order to promote a Bottom-Up approach and ensure ownership and leadership of the States in the planning process, States were, first supported to develop their MTBESPs and subsequently, the Plans were aggregated into the NMTBESP. The NMTBESP also addresses the priority pillars of the MSP while capturing the state realities and other UBEC areas of intervention.

The MTBESP development process began with a series of capacity building activities aimed at strengthening the core planning teams of Directors of Planning at SMOE and SUBEBs as well as Desk Officers to acquire technical skills in planning. This was a way of preparing them to develop and speak to their plans in their own way using the guidelines that have been provided. Training was participative and provided in three separate meetings before the actual plan development process began.

To support the States in developing the plans, elaborate guidance was further provided to States detailing actions for each stage of the plan development process. The following processes were followed.

- A. Guidelines: The guideline that the plan document would follow was provided to states. The broad headings of the guidelines are:
 - i. Context/background
 - ii. Introduction
 - iii. Sector analysis
 - iv. Policy and strategy
 - v. Programmes of action
 - vi. Monitoring and Evaluation (M&E)
- B. Assuring quality and use of evidence: States were also encouraged to ensure that their Plans comply with the following quality assurance measures:
 - i. establishment of a structure of Steering and Technical Committees
 - ii. consistent with their State Education Sector Plans;
 - iii. informed by baseline information contained in the State level Annual School

- Census (ASC);
- iv. funded through Federal, State and Local Budget Appropriations to Basic Education (over the timeframe of the Medium Term Expenditure Framework);
 - v. lay out quantitative objectives on Access and Quality of Basic Education, using information captured by the ASC and other official sources of information (such as UBEC's NPA, Learning Assessment Reports Household Surveys, etc.);
 - vi. grounded on a sound Planning Methodology (specified for project appraisal, selection and prioritization);
 - vii. factored in feedbacks from stakeholders including School-Based Management Committees (SBMCs) on school performance.
 - viii. State-level activities required for the formation of various Committees (Steering, Technical and Core Planning Teams) who share the responsibility for advocating for and actually developing the MTBESPs.

1.3.5 Review of Plans

The first outputs were the draft plans that the States had developed. Initial drafts plans were developed by States and submitted to UBEC for inputs after state level finalization activities. The Plans developed by States were then reviewed, harmonized, aggregated and then finalized at three Meetings. The reviews were guided by each State's compliance with the guidelines which focused broadly on the following areas:

- i. Structure of presentation (goals, objectives mitigation measures etc.);**
 - Link with the MSP;
 - Sources of data utilised; coherence of action plan;
 - Costed work plan (are sources verifiable?)
 - Monitoring and evaluation plans.

- ii. Coverage of challenge areas:**
 - ECCDE
 - Out-of-school children (enrolment drives)
 - Literacy (Early grade reading)
 - Learning assessment etc.

- iii. Coverage of issues of:**
 - Equity (gender, geography, disability, socio-economic status etc.)
 - Emergency preparedness/resilience.

1.3.6 Organisation of the MTBESPs

The SMTBESPs and the NMTBESP reflect seven (7) Basic Education components of the

ten (10) Pillars of the MSP which underpin the strategic priorities identified by States. They are:

- i. Out-of-School Children;
- ii. Adult Education and Special Needs Education;
- iii. Teacher Education, Capacity Building and Professional Development;
- iv. Curriculum and Policy Matters at Basic and Secondary Education;
- v. Education Data and Planning;
- vi. Information Communication Technology (ICT) in education; and
- vii. Library Services in Education.

While the SMTBESPs are organised in six (6) chapters, the NMTBESP is organised around the seven pillars in four (4) sections. Section one provides the background of the implementation of the UBE programme since 1999 when it was launched; insight into how the NMTBESP was developed and organized, the situation of Basic Education in Nigeria today - using the three parameters of Access, Quality and System Strengthening and the Policy Objectives guiding the three result areas of the Plan and the broad strategies for actualising each of the Policy Objectives—Access, Quality and System Strengthening as well as the Funding/Financing Framework that is largely a consolidation of the three-year costs of the programme for each of the 36 states and FCT.

Section two focuses on the Management and Quality Assurance which identifies Agencies that are responsible for delivery; explains the implementation mechanism for the overall UBE Programme and the M&E framework of the plans respectively. Section three is based on the States' Medium Term Basic Education Strategic Plan for all the 36 States and the FCT, using the three parameters of access, quality and system strengthening. Finally, the fourth section provides the harmonized Medium Term Basic Education Strategic Plan (MTBESP) of the 3 Coordinating Agencies' (UBEC, NMEC & NCNE) also using the three parameters of access, quality and system strengthening.

1.3.7 The Result Areas

As in the MSP, priority actions have been grouped into the following results areas: access, quality and systems strengthening.

Access

- Out-of-School children
- Adult and Non-formal education
- Special needs education
- Basic Education
 - Pre-primary (ECCDE)
 - Primary
 - Junior Secondary School
 - Nomadic

Quality

- Physical Infrastructure
- Teacher Professional Development (TPD)
- Instructional Materials
- Curriculum
- Early Reading and Numeracy
- Quality Assurance
- Monitoring Learning Assessment (MLA)
- Sports/recreation
- TVET

System strengthening

- Annual School Census
- EMIS
- Strategic Planning, Implementation and Monitoring
- Research and development
- ICT in education
- Library services
- Personnel Audit.

1.3.8 Financing framework

The following sources of fund for financing the development and implementation of the NMTBESP and SMTBESPs were identified as funds:

- i. allocated by States for delivery of Basic Education;
- ii. accessed from UBEC (FGN/UBE Intervention Funds from the Consolidated Revenue Fund - CRF of the Federal Government);
- iii. accessed from the Sustainable Development Goals' Office in the Presidency;
- iv. accessed from IDPs such as Results-Based Financing of Program-for-Results of the World Bank (which are to be based on verified Disbursement Linked Indicators and not inputs for project implementation);
- v. accessed from other individuals, philanthropists, NGOs, CSOs, etc., for the development of the basic education sub-sector.

1.4 Situation Analysis

Education is the key agent of change and development in any society as it prepares and equips the citizenry to effectively discharge their responsibilities for national development. In this 21st century, education must enable the child to acquire requisite knowledge, skills and competencies to function in the society. Thus education provided must be qualitative and functional to all eligible citizens.

1.4.1 The National Context

Nigeria is located in the continent of Africa in the Gulf of Guinea. It lies between Longitude 2.660°E and 14.680°E (of the prime meridian) and between Latitude 4.280°N and 13.890°N (of the Equator). Thus, Nigeria lies between the Equator and the Tropic of Cancer. It shares land borders with Chad in the north-east, Niger in the north, Benin in the west, Cameroon in the south-east and the Atlantic Ocean in the south. It covers 910,768 square kilometers of land and 13,000 square kilometers of water, making it the 32nd largest nation in the world with a total area of 923,768 square kilometres and a projected population of 196 million in 2018 (NPopC, 2018). The population density is 204.28/km².

Nigeria gained its independence in 1960 from Britain and runs a presidential system of government. It is structured into thirty-six (36) states and a federal capital territory (FCT) and seven hundred and seventy-four (774) local government areas. Its currency is the Naira (NGN - N).

Map of Nigeria

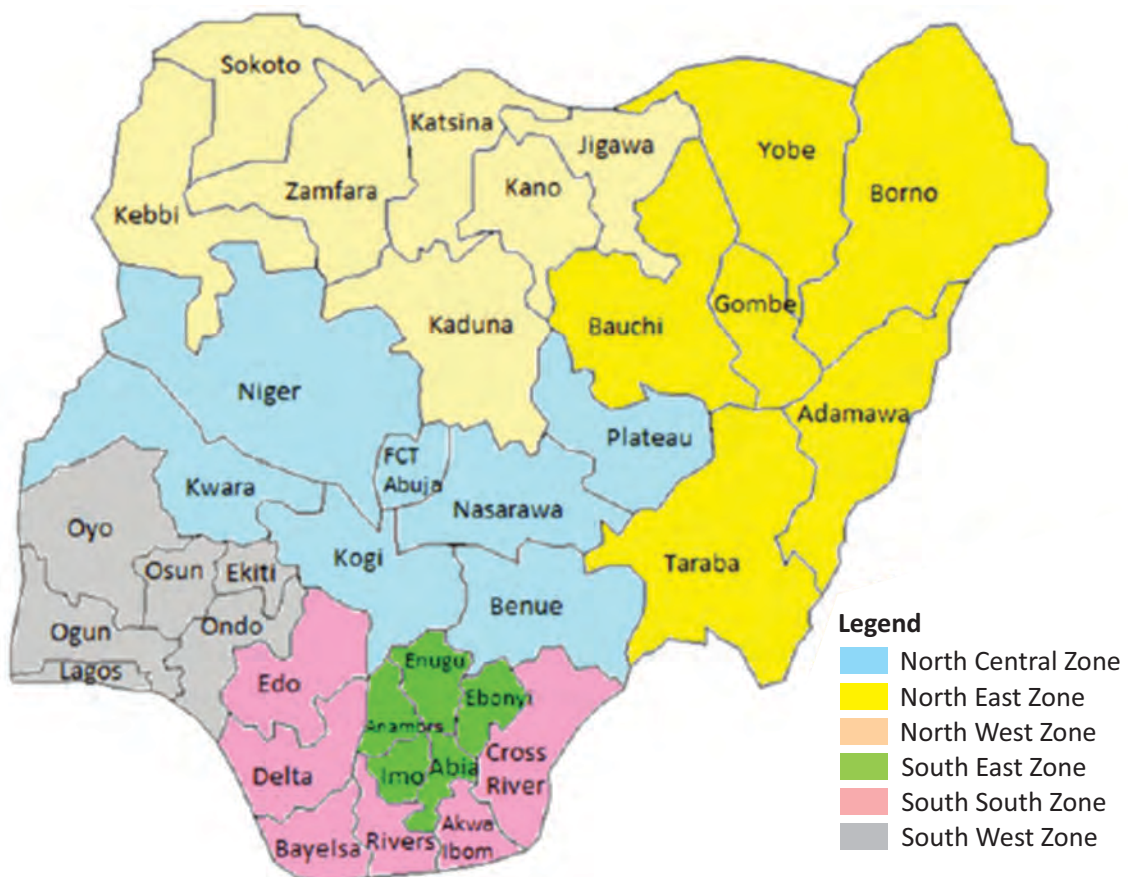


Fig.1: Map of Nigeria by State and Zone

Nigeria is rich in arable agricultural land and is blessed with numerous mineral and agricultural resources. The mineral resources include petroleum/natural gas, coal, bitumen, iron ore, gypsum, gold, talc, lead, zinc, bentonite and baryte, gemstones (like sapphire, ruby, etc.), kaolin, rock salt, etc. The agricultural resources include beans, sesame, cashew nut, cassava, cocoa bean, groundnut, gum Arabic, kolanut, maize (corn), melon, millet, palm kernel, palm oil, plantain, rice, rubber, sorghum, soybean, banana, yam, cotton, etc. The GDP is 375.8 billion USD (2017) and the GDP per capita is 1,968.56 USD (2017).

The top 10 export products of Nigeria are cocoa beans, cigarettes, sesame seeds, fertilizer, frozen sea foods, cocoa butter, finished leather, rubber, cashew nuts/kernels and naphtha. Others are petroleum and petroleum products, dry beans, ginger, tobacco, wood products, metals, plastics, textiles, solid minerals, cocoa paste, cocoa cake, cocoa beans, cocoa liquor, yam, honey, shea nuts, etc. (NEPC, 2016).

Nigeria has many natural landmarks and wildlife reserves, which include Cross River, Yankari and Borgu National Parks. The major geographical features are the Adamawa highlands; Mambilla, Jos and Obudu Plateaus; and Rivers Niger and Benue as well as the Niger Delta.

The country has over 250 ethnic groups, cultures and languages. Socio-economic factors result in significant mobility of Nigerians of multiple ethnic and religious backgrounds to reside in other parts of the country outside their ethnic or religious backgrounds, resulting in the intermixing of the various ethnic and religious groups, especially in the cities. However, the English language is the lingua franca of Nigerians. The Nigerian citizens are of different religious faiths, although Christianity, Islam and to a certain extent Traditional African Religion are the dominant ones.

1.4.2 Administration of Education

In Nigeria, the establishment and management of educational institutions at all levels is liberalized. Thus, any individual, religious organizations, local, state and federal governments can establish and manage any type of educational institution subject to guidelines provided by the different regulatory agencies..

The administration of education at all levels in Nigeria, including Basic Education, is guided principally by the ***National Policy on Education***. Other documents include Vision 20:2020 (2009), National Economic Empowerment and Development Strategy (NEEDS) (2004), Roadmap for the Nigerian Education Sector (2009), Education Sector Analysis (2000), UNESCO Report on Nigerian Education (2014), etc.

The National Policy on Education and the Roadmap for the Nigerian Education Sector provide the structure of Education in Nigeria and it is as follows:

- i. Three (3) years of Early Childhood Care Development and Education (ECCDE).
- ii. Six (6) years of Primary Education.
- iii. Three (3) years of Junior Secondary Education. One outcome of this sub-structure is Basic Education Certificate (BEC) issued by the National Examinations Council (NECO) and/or appropriate body in the States and the FCT after being successful in the Basic Education Certificate Examination (BECE). Other outcomes are the National Business Certificate (NBC) and National Technical Certificate (NTC) issued by the National Business and Technical Examinations Board (NABTEB) for products of Technical Colleges and allied institutions.
- iv. Three (3) years of Senior Secondary Education. The outcome is the Senior School Certificate (SSC) issued by the National Examinations Council (NECO) and/or the West African Senior School Certificate (WASSC) issued by the West African Examinations Council (WAEC) after being successful in the Senior School Certificate Examination (SSCE). Other Certificates issued at this level by the National Business and Technical Examinations Board (NABTEB) for products of Technical Colleges and allied institutions are Advanced National Business Certificate (ANBC) and Advanced National Technical Certificate (ANTC). At this level also, Nigeria operates Vocational Enterprise Institutions (VEIs) for the purpose of acquiring **National Vocational Certificate (NVC)** in various Trades.
- v. Three (3) to six (6) years of Tertiary Education in colleges of education, polytechnics and universities. The colleges of education issue the Nigeria Certificate in Education (NCE), while the polytechnics issue the National Diploma (ND) and the Higher National Diploma (HND). The universities issue Bachelor degrees in the various fields. Nigeria also operates Innovation Enterprise Institutions (IEIs) for the purpose of acquiring **National Innovation Diploma (NID)** in various fields.

1.4.3 Basic Education Situation

The Basic Education sub-sector is plagued by a myriad of problems. Issues of access, equity, quality, infrastructure and funding have been identified to impact negatively and thus limiting the optimal performance of the sub-sector.

1.4.3.1 Access

There has been a rapid expansion in access as recorded in the 2018 National Personnel Audit (NPA) Report.

The 2018 Basic Education statistics for both public and private schools from the States

indicate increases in number of institutions and enrolments. At the ECCDE level, there are 81,562 ECCDE centres/sections with an enrolment of 7,159,262 learners, about 50% of whom are boys. There are 113,450 primary schools with an enrolment of 27,889,387 learners, with girls constituting about 47%. At the Junior Secondary level, there are 31,017 JS schools with an enrolment of 6,841,953 learners made up of 3,536,635 boys (52%) and 3,305,318 girls (48%). The data reveal no huge gap in enrolment between boys and girls at the three levels of Basic Education.

These figures indicate that 81,562 ECCDE sections exist in 72% of the 113,450 primary schools. In the same vein, for every 4 primary schools, there is only 1 JSS. There is no significant difference in the enrolment of boys and girls in the figures.

The statistics show that there are 154,217 teachers (Males: 13,637 - 9% and Females: 140,580 – 91%) in the ECCDE centres/sections; 913,579 teachers (Males: 422,223 - 46% and Females: 491,356 – 54%); in the primary schools, and a total of 382,346 teachers (Males: 214,996 - 56% and Females: 167,350 – 44%) teachers, in the JSS. Also, there are 1,939 non-teaching staff (Males: 585 - 30% and Females: 1,354 – 70%) in the ECCDE centres/sections and 148,980 non-teaching staff (Males: 62,342 - 42% and Females: 86,638 – 58%) in the primary schools as well as a total of 66,826 non-teaching staff (Males: 32,088 - 48% and Females: 34,738 – 52%) in junior secondary schools. In all, while there were more female teachers (except in JSS), female non-teaching staff were more than their male counterparts in all other levels collated although not at a significant level.

The data from the NPA further show that there are 661 Almajiri/Tsangaya Schools with enrolment of 841,165 learners (Boys 653,715 –78% and Girls 187,450 - 22%). With 6,550 teachers (Males: 5,290 - 81% and Females: 1,260 – 19%) and 582 non-teaching staff (Males: 394- 68% and Females: 188 – 32%) in the schools.

The Returns reveal 2,146 Nomadic schools with enrolment of 149,018 learners (Boys 99,211 - 67% and Girls: 49,807 –33%) in Nigeria. Furthermore, there are 9,619 teachers (Males: 7,124- 74% and Females: 2,495– 26%) and 890 non-teaching staff (Males: 628 - 71% and Females: 262 – 29%) in the schools.

Data is also returned for special needs education. For Special Needs Education, there are 905 centres operating at different levels (823– ECCDE/Pre-primary/ Primary and 82 – Junior Secondary) in Nigeria with total enrolment of 578,920 (Boys 380,001- 66% and Girls: 198,919 –34%). 544,088 pupils (Boys 357,489 - 66% and Girls: 186,599 –34%) are enrolled at ECCDE/Pre-primary/Primary, with 34,832 learners (Boys -22,512

– 65% and Girls: 12,320 – 35%) enrolled at the JSS level. While there are 6,985 teachers (Males: 3,226 - 46% and Females: 3,759 – 54%), there were 1,921 (Males: 839 - 44% and Females: 1,082 – 66%) non-teaching staff in the centres/sections.

1.4.3.2 Quality

The determinants of quality are embedded in the key aspects of input, process and outcome. Deriving from statistical indicators, inputs include; teacher/learners ratio, qualified teacher/learners ratio, percentage of qualified teachers, classroom/learners ratio, text-book/learners ratio, etc. Process factors such as methodology, classroom management capacity, teacher support services, opportunity for continuous professional development of teachers and other classroom dynamics also impact on quality. Similarly, output and outcome factors such as learners' cumulative continuous assessment scores, performance in national examinations, graduate on-the-job performance, etc., constitute quality and efficiency indicators.

Teachers are the drivers of the education system. However, the quality of teachers produced by teacher education institutions and their classroom performance has been adjudged unsatisfactory. Using learners' performance as a proxy measure of teacher quality, the results of the current Monitoring of Learning Achievement (MLA) at which performance of learners was below 50 per cent in Literacy, Numeracy and Life Skills, the poor quality of teaching is evident. Furthermore, 50% of children who are in school in Nigeria are not attaining the learning outcome benchmarks - about 63% of children who live in rural areas cannot read at all; and as much as 84% of children in the lowest economic quintile cannot also read at all (FME,2016).The situation is exacerbated by the shortage of qualified teachers at all levels of basic education.

The NPA showed that about 65,731 teachers representing 43%of teachers in ECCDE; 345,546 in primary schools and 90,585 in JSS did not have the minimum qualification of NCE prescribed in the policy on education for a teacher in Education teacher.

1.4.3.3 Infrastructure

It is common knowledge that infrastructural facilities in most Basic Education schools in Nigeria are inadequate and in some cases non-existent. The lack of essential infrastructure and the very poor state of the physical facilities at the basic education sub-sector pose serious threat to the attainment of the SDGs. Government Reports allude to high deficiency in basic infrastructural facilities that make learning conducive. They include access roads, buildings, classrooms, furniture, and toilets among others. Many classrooms had no covers, door lids and ceiling. Children sat on the floor to take lessons and teachers had no tables or chairs. Apart from classrooms, every school is expected to have a library.

UBEC in collaboration with the SUBEBs and other partners, has over the years done so much in the provision of new classroom buildings and renovation/rehabilitation of existing ones in many basic education schools. However, these are not only inadequate but the quality of some of them leaves much to be desired.

The efforts made by UBEC, SUBEBs and other partners seem not to have yielded the desired results due to the growing expansion in the basic education sub-sector. Tables 1.1a-1.1c show the classroom gaps in basic education (ECCDE, Primary and Junior Secondary). As can be seen from the Tables, the classroom gap as at 2018 is 65,214. The gap in primary schools is 269,516, while that of JSS is 47,602 classrooms. These gaps are very wide and require urgent intervention if the children must learn in a conducive environment.

1.4.3.4 Funding

Funding of Basic Education has come primarily from the Federal, States and Local Governments' resources over the years. Though Government funding of Basic Education has been inadequate, this has been supplemented by funds from other sources such as private organisations (2% Education Tax), community organisations and levies paid by parents etc. In addition, funding support also comes from bilateral and multilateral sources such as Japan International Cooperation Agency (JICA), Korea International Cooperation Agency (KOICA), and Global Partnership for Education (GPE), United Nations Children's Fund (UNICEF), United Nations Education, Scientific and Cultural Organization (UNESCO), United States Agency for International Development (USAID) and Department for International Development (DFID) etc.

1.4.3.5 Challenges in Basic Education

The prevalent challenges in the Basic Education sub-sector have informed the MTBESP and the emerging NMTBESP. Extant findings from situation analyses at national and state levels have revealed some of the fundamental challenges that impinge on the Basic Education system. Similarly, an analysis of the Plans submitted by each of the 36 States and the FCT indicated some critical challenges that need to be addressed. These include the prevalence of out-of-school children, low coverage of Early Childhood Care Development and Education (ECCDE) programmes, poor levels of reading among learners, poor provision for learners with special needs, poor learning outcomes and inadequate funding. These challenges manifest in the 36 States and the FCT in various degrees. Each State and the FCT have captured these priority areas in their Plans according to the degree to which they are affected.

Also, the States' Plans have recognized and built in crisis-sensitivity, resilience and conflict mitigation measures in various aspects including textbooks, other instructional materials, and Teacher Professional Development (TPD). The overarching thrust is to enhance the resilience of the system to respond to crisis; and prevent or mitigate the degrees of conflict by targeting and addressing the drivers of conflicts at institutional and school levels. The role of School-Based Management Committees (SBMCs) has also been highlighted in all the Plans as community level agents of change that must begin to engage differently with school management and linking with community level development in enhancing quality and mitigating conflict respectively.

1.4.5 Redressing Challenges/Gaps

Fragmentation and silo operations among Basic Education agencies were other issues identified by situation analysis as impeding the effectiveness of Basic Education programmes. UBEC sought to redress this through the planning process. Thus, a pre-condition for the acceptance of Plans was that SUBEBs work with State Ministries of Education (SMoEs) in developing the Plans. This will ensure that although the planned activities will be implemented by UBEC and SUBEBs, SMoEs had adequate knowledge of and made inputs into the Plans. The SMTBESPs and the emergent NMTBESPs were, therefore, prepared by SUBEBs and UBEC in collaboration with the State Ministries of Education (SMoE), Budget and Planning, and the core Planning Departments. All the States' Plans were subjected to further stakeholder consultations before they were finalized.

The approval of the Better Education Service Delivery for All (BESDA) Programme during this period introduced more elements that will position affected States to benefit from BESDA. It is envisaged that the UBE State Action Plans will eventually be used as policy dialogue instruments with State Governments on progress achieved in the implementation of the UBE Programme in terms of access and quality of Basic Education and on State performance with regard to Disbursement Linked Indicators (DLIs) under the BESDA operation.

SECTION TWO

Section Two focuses on Management and Quality Assurance procedures required for quality programme implementations and sustainable effective coordination of the resources, interventions and activities of all Coordinators and Implementers.

2.0 Management and Quality Assurance

The effective implementation mechanism of the overall UBE Programme has implications for the major stakeholders of Basic Education. These include UBEC, SMOEs, SUBEBs, LGEAs, CBOs, NGOs, FBOs and SBMCs.

The coordinating agencies of Basic Education in Nigeria cut across the three tiers of Government. At the federal level, the main agency coordinating the implementation of basic education is the Universal Basic Education Commission (UBEC). Other agencies involved are National Commission for Nomadic Education (NCNE), the National Commission for Mass Literacy and Adult and Non-Formal Education (NMEC). At the State level, the State Ministries of Education play major coordinating roles, while the implementation of basic education is the responsibility of the State Universal Basic Education Boards (SUBEBs) and the State Agencies for Adult and Non-formal Education. At the LGA level, the implementation agency is the Local Government Education Authority (LGEA).

In order for the school to deliver qualitative education to its learners, governments at the three levels are to:

- provide safe working and learning environments for teachers and learners respectively;
- provide easy access to good sanitation and first-aid facilities;
- provide Guidance and Counselling services;
- ensure safe and balanced meals; and
- ensure that the Basic National Curricula and Syllabi and other necessary instructional materials are in use in ECCDE centres, primary and junior secondary schools.

2.1 Management Process and Implementation of the NMTBESP

Following the established structure, the NMTBESP, which evolved through a Bottom-Up approach during the harmonization of the Basic Education component of SESOPs from the 36 States of the Federation and the FCT, will also be coordinated within the mechanism of Basic Education delivery. The NMTBESP, to a large extent, brings the

entire Basic Education sub-sector under the same umbrella through which implementation will be streamlined for the purpose of ensuring that managers in the sub-sector all over the country provide efficient and effective Universal Basic Education to all school-going age children in Nigeria.

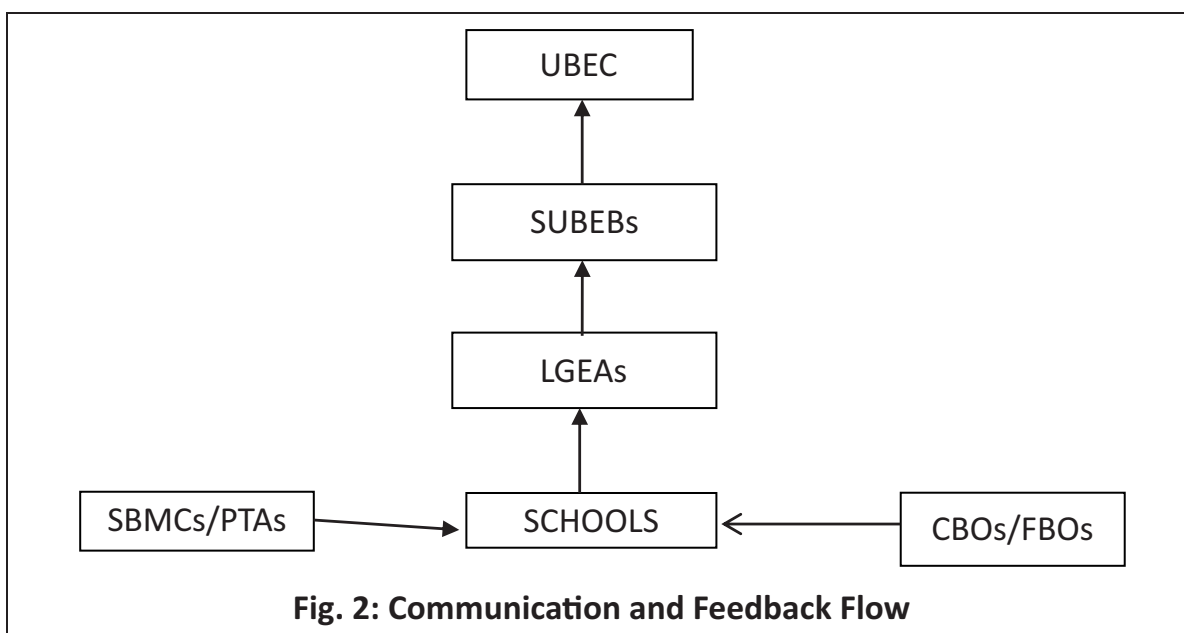
2.1.1 Performance Review

The Nigerian Constitution provides a model of shared educational governance among the three-tiers of government. To that extent, while the federal government provides policy guidelines, States are mandated with the responsibilities for policy interpretations and implementation, and the local governments are to ensure that education is delivered at the school level. The most significant framework that specifically promotes partnership in basic education is the UBE Act, 2004. It provides for the establishment of the Commission, State UBE Boards and Local Government Education Authorities.

In view of this, therefore, there is need for a robust partnership among UBEC, SUBEBs and the LGEAs. This equally extends to the involvement of other stakeholders such as the school, head teachers, SBMCs, PTAs, NGOs/CBOs/FBOs, IDPs, etc.

2.1.2 Effective Communication

Flow of communication and feedback during the development of the NMTBESP followed both the bottom-up and top-down approaches. UBEC could initiate interactions with the SUBEBs and vice versa. Such engagements could employ meetings, phone calls, letters and e-mails and constant review of plans and feedback. This, to a large extent, will secure the buy-in and commitment of SUBEBs towards the implementation of the Plans. The schema below depicts the communication flow for effective management and implementation of the NMTBESP.



The Meetings of the Forum of UBEC Management with SUBEB Directors in-charge of Planning will continue to be held twice a year and the Directors will be required to present progress report on a uniform template which would outline the levels of the implementation of their plans. This progress report would form part of the template to be employed during the bi-annual monitoring by Planning Staff of UBEC.

2.1.3 Measuring Progress

There will be bi-annual monitoring of SUBEBs compliance with their plans in the areas of access, quality and system strengthening. This is sequel to the Commission's assessment of the Action Plans submitted by SUBEBs to the Commission for compliance. The following Key Performance Indicators will be assessed:

2.1.3.1 Access

- i. Gross Intake Rate in Primary 1.
- ii. Number of children accessing primary 1 in formal education .
- iii. Number of children accessing Basic Literacy programme in the non-formal setting.
- iv. Number of children accessing grade one/first level in formal or non-formal education.

2.1.3.2 Quality

- i. Textbook-Pupil ratio/ Basic Primer-Learner ratio.
- ii. Classroom/student ratio.
- iii. Percentage (%) of schools with adequate seating arrangement.
- iv. Percentage (%) of schools with potable drinking water.
- v. Pupil-Toilet Ratio.
- vi. Number/% of teachers/facilitators (formal and non-formal) who received in-service training.
- vii. Proportion of qualified teachers (Percentage) by national standards.
- viii. Proportion (Percentage)of teachers who are female.

2.1.3.3 System Strengthening

- i. Number of States with functional EMIS reporting data to federal.
- ii. Percentage (%) of school heads trained on keeping accurate school records.
- iii. Percentage (%) of facilitators trained on keeping accurate school records.
- iv. Number of States with EMIS that transparently feeds findings back to communities or school management committees.

- v. ICTs in Education.
- vi. Percentage (%) of schools with access to computers for pedagogical purposes—Primary, JSS.
- vii. Number of States implementing SMTBESPs.

2.2 Execution/Implementation

One of the key requirements in the implementation of NMTBESP and SMTBESPs is the constitution of an Implementation Committee.

2.2.1 National Level Implementation Committee

a. Composition and Membership

At the National Level, this Committee shall be headed by the Director, Planning, Research and Statistics of UBEC with the following members:

- i. The Director, Finance and Accounts
- ii. The Director, Physical Planning
- iii. The Director, Academic Services
- iv. The Director, Quality Assurance
- v. The Director, Social Mobilization
- vi. The Director, Special Programmes
- vii. The Coordinator, FTS
- viii. The Programme Officer, Tsangaya Programme
- ix. The Head of Unit, Procurement
- x. The Relevant Desk Officers

b. Responsibilities

The responsibilities of the Committee in UBEC shall include the following:

- i. Assessment of SUBEB Action Plans to ensure that they are drawn from the SMTBESPs.
- ii. Preparation for defence of SUBEB Action Plans at the Commission.
- iii. Ensuring that costing for projects and programmes are realistic and not ambiguous.
- iv. Preparation of Annual Budget.
- v. Ensuring that due process is followed in awarding contracts.
- vi. Ensuring that a separate Action Plan on unutilized funds in the previous year would be prepared and executed in the current year.

2.2.2 State Level Implementation Committees

a. Composition and Membership

At the State Level, the Implementation Committee shall be headed by the Director,

Planning, Research and Statistics of the SUBEBs with the following members:

- i. The Director, Finance and Accounts
- ii. The Director, Academic Services or School Services
- iii. The Director, Quality Assurance
- iv. The Director, Social Mobilization
- v. The Head of Projects
- vi. The Relevant Desk Officers

b. Responsibilities

The Committee will report to the respective Executive Chairmen and ensure that:

- i. action Plans are prepared in line with the SMTBESP;
- ii. projects to be executed in various locations are based on “Needs Assessments” and are prioritized;
- iii. projects and programmes are executed within the timeline;
- iv. progress of implementation is reviewed biannually;
- v. thorough supervision of their projects and programmes are carried out;
- vi. due process is followed in awarding contracts;
- vii. progress Report on implementation, challenges and the way forward of addressing those challenges are communicated to the Executive Chairmen; and
- viii. Implementation Committees are also set up at the LGEA and School levels.

2.2.3 Responsibilities of the LGEAs

The following are the Responsibilities of the LGEAs. They shall:

- i. carry out Needs Assessment of all the basic education infrastructural facilities;
- ii. categorized needs in order of importance;
- iii. select appropriate schools for location of projects;
- iv. supervise activities, projects, and programmes in their LGEAs;
- v. report progress of implementation to their Education Secretaries who will forward same to SUBEBs.

2.2.4 Responsibilities of the Schools

The following are the Responsibilities of the Schools

- i. Monitor the implementation of the projects in their schools.
- ii. Present progress report of implementation of project to the LGEAs.

2.3 Quality Assurance: Monitoring and Evaluation

In the context of Quality Assurance, Monitoring and Evaluation (M&E) is a very important aspect of management and implementation processes of the MTBESPs. Without a proper M&E framework, the attainment of the goals and objectives of the Plan cannot be ascertained. Government investments in education seek to align with the expenditure framework which is meant to achieve policy objectives, effective and

efficient utilization of available resources towards achieving expected results/outcomes and impacts. A robust Monitoring and Evaluation system, therefore, gives insight to past experiences, on-going policy implementation, allocation of resources, review of progress, reporting of findings and sharing of feedbacks with education stakeholders.

The NMTBESP has designed tracking system for supporting States to track and report on their performances. This will entail a process of developing an aggregated monitoring and evaluation framework to track implementation. This will be in the form of an Annual Status of Implementation Report (ASIR) which will document the implementation status for each year. The ASIR will be produced as from 2019.

The Assessment of the MTBESP will begin as soon as implementation of programmes and projects commences. This is aimed at identifying successes made and challenges encountered in the process of implementation and where necessary, to adopt new methodologies in addressing identified challenges with a view to ensuring that the desired results are attained.

To assess the level of compliance of SUBEBs in the use of the MTBESPs, UBEC will set up an Action Plan Assessment Committee comprising relevant Departments/Units to check Action Plans before approvals are granted. If the Action Plans are in line with the MTBESP, approval will be granted by the Executive Secretary. The Commission would also ensure that due process is followed in the award of contracts for implementation.

In order to ensure partnership, transparency and accountability, the M & E processes will involve UBEC and various Education Stakeholders at the different levels, such as the Federal Ministry of Education (FME); National Commission for Nomadic Education (NCNE); National Commission for Mass Literacy, Adult and Non-Formal Education (NMEC); Civil Society Organizations (CSOs); International Development Partners (IDPs); School-Based Management Committees (SBMCs) in collaboration with State Universal Basic Education Boards (SUBEBs) and Local Government Education Authorities (LGEAs).

SECTION THREE

b. Quality priority area is centred on the following components:

- l. Physical Infrastructure
- ii. Teacher Professional Development (TPD)
- iii. Instructional Materials
- iv. Curriculum Modules
- v. Early Reading and Numeracy
- vi. Quality Assurance
- vii. Monitoring of Learning Achievement
- viii. Sports/Recreation
- ix. Library Materials/Services

c. System strengthening priority area is centred on the following components:

- l. Annual School Census (ASC)
- ii. Education Management Information System (EMIS)
- iii. Strategic Planning, Implementation and Monitoring
- iv. Research and Development
- v. ICT in Education
- vi. Library Services
- vii. Education Sector Management

APPENDIX

Guidelines for review of State Medium Term Basic Education Strategic Plan (MTBESP)

A. Output: A short document reflecting the extent of the compliance of State Plans with the Guidelines provided.

1. Review compliance with the guidelines:
 - Structure of presentation (goals, objectives mitigation measures etc.);
 - Link with the MSP;
 - Sources of data utilised;
 - Coherence of action plan;
 - Costed work plan (are sources verifiable?)
 - Monitoring and Evaluation Plans;
2. Coverage of challenge areas:
 - ECD,
 - Out-of-school children (enrolment drives)
 - Learning
 - Early grade reading
 - Learning assessment etc.
3. Coverage of issues of:
 - Equity (gender, geography, disability, wealth, etc.)
 - Emergency preparedness/resilience

B. Aggregation (Merging) of State MTBESP into the National Medium Term Basic Education Strategic Plan.

1. A general introduction – all-encompassing and summarises the highlights by state with general commentary of the state compliance with the guidelines stipulated for their plan preparation (in above section).
2. A synthesis of the situation analysis – thematic summation of critical issues and priorities from state plans. Comments should be made on the extent to which the states focused on the issues and challenges as in 2&3 above. Sum up based on evidence, the issues that should constitute the national focus.
3. Synthesis of the policy options and risk mitigation strategies. This should inform UBEC's summation of the national priorities and presented here.
4. Summary of costs and breakdown by state by priority areas. Identify and place in a table form, the highlights for each state: focus of intervention; annual targets and costs e.g. teachers, how many and at what cost per year? National focus and component of cost.
5. Overall soundness of M&E for each state. National focus of M&E.

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
